

## The Rebel Wheel

Steeped in dark cinematic sound-scapes and complex, turn-on-a-dime arrangements, The Rebel Wheel features a frenetic mix of angular rock aggression, jazz phrasing, complex harmonies and unpredictable odd-meter vamps. Formed in 2003, the floating lineup has gradually solidified to the current four piece featuring guitars, keyboards, drums and bass, while the music has focused more on a modern, genre-blending experimental progressive rock approach.

Based in Ottawa, Ontario, The Rebel Wheel consists of leader David Campbell on guitars vocals and keyboards: Alex Wickham on drums, vocals, keyboards and percussion: Andrew Burns on bass, drums, vocals and keyboards and Marianne Dumas on keyboards, percussion and vocals.

While the band has experimented heavily with more modern electronic elements, their core sound is based on the dynamic interaction of real players and real instruments. At times large and dissonant, at other times lyrical and direct, The Rebel Wheel features strong playing, unique arrangements, unexpected sonics and a self-contained compositional symmetry.

In 2009, the band signed a deal with Atlanta Georgia's 10T Records and released the critically acclaimed albums, "Diagramma" and "We Are In The Time Of Evil Clocks". In 2013 they signed with Germany's Rostfrei Records where they remain to this day. Right now they are working on their latest CD, Simple Machines to be released in the summer of 2020.
